The National Service Scheme (NSS) had its birth on September 24, 1969, during the Gandhi time. The scheme was first launched in 37 universities comprising approxiamately 40,000 students.

Today the NSS has become the largest Government organization of students in the country comprising members from the +2 level to the college and university levels. The strength of volunteers has now increased to more than 40 lakhs, which makes the NSS one of the largest student forces in the world. The number of students strength increased from 40,000 to over 4.0 million up to the end of March 2023 students in various universities, colleges, and institutions of higher learning have volunteered to take part in various community service programs. Observed NSS Day (24.09.23)


